FLUSH BOOSTER

• Directions for The Rug Sucker (no Marinator):

Always test for color stability before applying to any textile(s). If color(s) are UNstable, use FlushBOOSTer for Bleeders (read ALL label instructions before proceeding). If color(s) are stable, wet-out rug completely (both sides) with cold, clear water. Treat BOTH sides of each rug with an even application of 2 oz. per gallon of FlushBOOSTer. Roll the rug up and allow a minimum of ten minutes dwell time so that Flush BOOSTer can penetrate all the fibers (allow more dwell time for more soiled conditions). Unroll the rug and agitate BOTH sides. Perform the 'Rug Sucker rinse and extraction' steps (see below).

• Directions for The Marinator+Rug Sucker (best results):

Always test for color stability before applying to any textile(s). If color(s) are UNstable, use FlushBOOSTer for Bleeders (read ALL label instructions before proceeding). If color(s) are stable, treat BOTH sides of each rug with an even application of 1-3 oz. per gallon of FlushBOOSTer (dilution is determined as per the guidelines on our website, see below). Roll the rug up and allow a minimum of ten minutes dwell time so that FlushBOOSTer can penetrate all the fibers (allow more dwell time for more soiled conditions). Fill The Marinator pond to capacity and connect The Rug Sucker Multi-tool to The Marinator pump (prime the Marinator pump). Lay the rug in The Marinator pond and prepare to 'pucker' the rug by starting the first roll underwater. Plug in The Marinator pump (the discharge hose should be outside the pond). Slowly roll the rug around The Rug Sucker

and add cold, fresh water to the pond as the contaminated water is flushed through the rug. Monitor the clear sight tube/elbow for an increase in clarity of the discharge water. Once the desired level of clarity is reached, place the discharge hose inside the Marinator pond and allow to circulate for a minimum of ten minutes. Once this 'marination' is complete, unplug the Marinator pump and release the side supports to drain the pond. Unroll the rug and agitate BOTH sides. Perform the 'Rug Sucker rinse and extraction' steps (see below).

• Rug Sucker Rinse and Extraction Steps:

Completely wet out the rug again and prepare it for a final rinse and extraction. Once the rug is 'puckered' up to The Rug Sucker Multi-tool, continue to add water as you roll the rug up to the final roll. Once the rug is resting on the final roll, continue to add cold, fresh water to the now rolled up rug. Monitor the clear sight tube/elbow for an increase in clarity of the rinse water. Continue this flushing action until desired results are reached, repeat if necessary. Allow the rug to be fully extracted, groom the pile and speed dry. Inspect for quality once the rug is completely dry.
